## SMALL SIDED GAMES RULE CHANGE

A change has been made to the eligibility criteria for SSG age groups as of 2012. These grades have been grouped by Football Brisbane as follows:

**U6/U7**

**U8/U9**

**U10/U11**

A player may only play up in the same group as their "true" age. For eg. If a player is 6, they can play in U7 but not U8. If they are 8 they can play in U9 but not

10 etc. Basically they can play up but only on the same size field. Only extenuating circumstances will be considered for exemption.

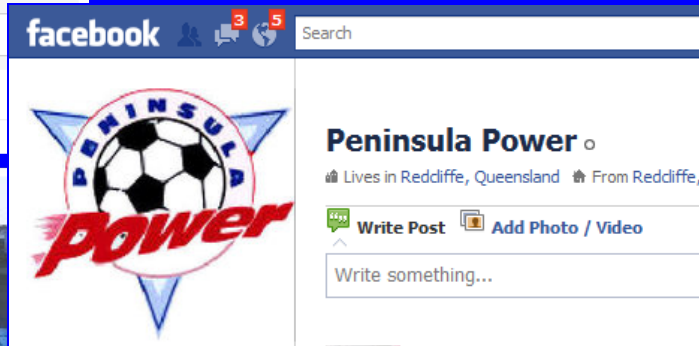

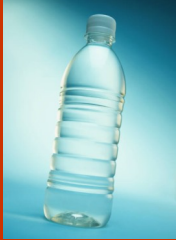
